- October meeting minutes approved.

#### 1. Lunchtime

Noted as a concern for some families. Perhaps not a widespread problem, but needs to be addressed.

Next steps: check in with teachers about snack time in every classroom, follow-up with individual families, and put out survey to 1st-2nd grade families if needed.

#### 2. Parking

Noted as a concern; along with safety issues during morning drop-off times.

Context: Families are parking in the fire lane, and bus lane; ECE parents have to sign-in in the classroom.

Steps we've taken so far: addressed individual families about fire lane, announcement in News from the Nest; parking signs and enforcement in the morning.

Next steps: Keep double-doors on playground open until 8:05; look into special location for ECE drop off; continue to communicate expectations about safe parking.

#### 3. Expansion

Starting construction next school year from Fall 2018- Aug 2019.

A Design Advisory Group will be formed to influence the final design and blueprints.

We are in the process of petitioning to expand the ECE Program to three classrooms.

#### 4. 21st Century Innovative Schools Bond Budget

\$40,000 Budget
Top Priorities agreed upon:

1. Flooring (carpet and tile) for four classrooms (rooms 204 - 207)

- 2. Hallway lighting for main floor and potentially two other east/west hallways (upstairs and downstairs)
- 3. Repaint Library/Media Center
- 4. Modern furniture for Library/Media Center

\*CSC did not prioritize purchase of a digital marquee with these funds.
