- September meeting minutes approved.
 1. **Review ECE Priorities** for enrollment for ECE-4. School has established priorities for neighborhood students (those within our boundary area) to have the first 3 priorities.
 2. **Budget-** We will save the carry forward money of \$110,000 for next year
 3. **Roadmap to the Future-** Survey Results presented - community perspective it to continue enhancing the great work already being done at McT, and do not suggest moving forward with a new model or a complete redesign of the school.
 4. **Expansion Timeline -** More news is coming soon, but we are moving forward with the expansion. Budget for the project has been secured and approved by City Council, DPS, and DURA (Denver Urban Renewal Authority).
 5. **Bond Budget= \$40,000** Established priorities: carpet for five classrooms and 1 office and staff lounge (?) and upgrade lighting, paint, and flooring in main hallway by office.
 6. **Tech Bond= \$13,000** Priorities: mobile computer lab and digital sign. We will approach the PTA about the possibility of donating towards MCT digital sign.
 7. **Next week: SPF Framework will be released.**
