Why join the Cub Scouts?

FUN--boys join Cub Scouting because they want to have fun.

IDEALS--spiritual and character growth, citizenship training, and personal fitness.

INTERESTS & SKILLS--participate in a broad array of activities, and learn new things.

ADVENTURE--take part in skits, games, field trips, service projects, outdoor activities, etc.

How are the Pack and Dens organized?

The pack is structured into five scouting ranks and has at least one den for each grade between first and fifth. Tigers (1st grade), Wolves (2nd grade), Bears (3rd grade), Webelos I (4th grade), Webelos II (5th grade).

What is the time commitment?

Cub Scouts meet in their dens 2-3 times a month, and a pack meeting is held for all Cub Scouts and their families once a month. Pack meetings include special speakers, events and skits.

There is usually at least one optional special den or pack activity, such as a hike, service project or other outing per month.

How much does it cost?

The annual registration fee for the pack is \$50. This covers the national registration of your son as a Cub Scout and his Boy's Life magazine subscription. The pack will also supply each scout with their **manual, neckerchief and slide**. The pack raises the remainder of the money needed for the program by selling popcorn.

Where can I purchase the Cub Scout uniform?

The Scout Shop: 10455 W. 6th Avenue, Lakewood, CO 80215. Scouts should purchase the needed shirt, patches and hat.

What should we do next?

April 27	Denver Area Council Scout Show: Come enjoy a fun day all about scouting. Shoot BB guns, race go-karts, play games, see other Packs, maybe even go fishing!
May 21	Rocket Launch: Come experience rocketry in its finest. The scouts will launch their own rockets as a great way to wrap up the year.
